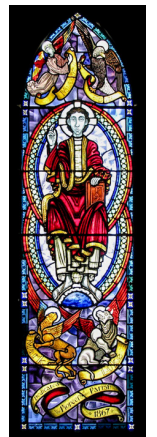
## HELP CANA COMMUNITIES
