Points made were:

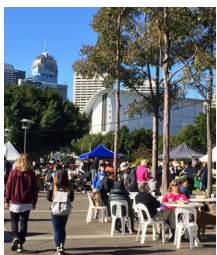
- this would bring mess, noise, traffic congestion and parking problems to Bank Street instead of the green open space and passive boating facilities promised in the Bays Precinct Transformation Plan - residents in stratas closest to Bank Street would be especially affected;
- dragon boaters are alarmed by the risks they would run from wash, poor visibility and large vessels cutting across their path as they move in and out of their moorings;
- everyone, especially families with children, is betrayed by the broken promise of a park and access to the water to "muck about in boats".

NBN has begun to install equipment in most JL strata plans (except those with existing fibre networks). Customers will be notified by their current service provider what they need to do to switch to NBN.
