WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION?

The Community Association (CA) manages our community facilities - The Station, tennis courts, Glasshouse pool and gym, the website. It also appoints the security service, and shares information about other contracts - strata management, cleaning and building management.

WHO REPRESENTS YOU?

The CA Executive Committee (CA EC) meets every two months, and all residents and owners are welcome to attend. It has 3 subcommittees - Finance & Services, Assets and IT. It has a maximum of 9 members, elected at the CA AGM from nominees of the stratas. At the moment there are only 6 members on the CA EC. Hopefully at their next general meeting some stratas will elect a nominee willing to give some time to our community.

The government will prepare a framework for regulating short term letting. Alex Greenwich MP has created a petition to lodge in Parliament calling for strata communities to be managed democratically and not have holiday lets forced upon them. 10,000 signatures will initiate a debate with both major parties likely to speak.
