

OUR COMMUNITY FACILITIES - REVIEW THE RULES

Jacksons Landing has several facilities for residents: the Station (the community hall with kitchen for private and community use) on Bowman Street, the Glasshouse pool and gym next to it, the tennis courts on John Street, and a meeting room in the estate management office. Many residents need help to use these facilities to the full - engaging a yoga teacher, tennis coach, swimming teacher, physiotherapist or fitness trainer.

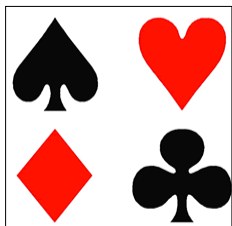
However, trainers may not run their businesses in our facilities: residents pay for their upkeep, and our Community Association manages them.
