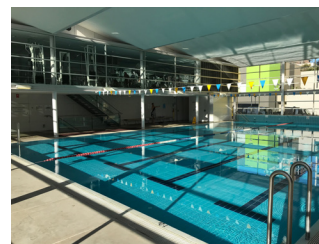


OUR COMMUNITY FACILITIES - REVIEWING THE RULES

NEW SECURITY CONTRACT

A Security Tender Working Group (Philip Bryan, Ashley Douglas, David Keetley, James Scandol), with the support of Colin Knowles, is managing the tender process to compose a new Security contract and select a provider. ProcureGroup is providing technical services for the tender and the Working Group is consulting all Strata Committees.

The Working Group will evaluate responses to the tender, and make a recommendation to the Stratas. The Working Group has no decision-making capacity: Strata Committees



and the Community Association will all select their security service provider, and enter into individual contracts. Strata Committees need not engage the service provider recommended by the Working Group. However, that outcome could fragment the security services across Jacksons Landing.
