

## YOUR COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION COULD USE YOUR HELP!

Jacksons Landing has 19 individual stratas, and an overarching Community Association (CA), whose primary role is to manage the community facilities - the Glasshouse pool and gym, the tennis courts, the security and access operations in the Gatehouse, and the website. It also helps stratas to engage contractors - cleaners, building managers, strata managers and insurance brokers, by preparing tender documentation, evaluating tenders, and making recommendations on contracts.
