

## SECURITY - EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

Jacksons Landing employs a very effective security company - AFS - who cooperate closely with the NSW Police. These services have prevented any overall increase in property crime. The general situation is secure, but some buildings have been targeted, especially in the underground parking areas. Police have investigated our properties and will present their Risk Assessment report to the Community Association.

Meanwhile we must accept that security is everyone's responsibility: each strata committee should assess risks and remedy them – and so should every resident.

Thieves love unlocked cages in car parks, and some residents leave their cages unlocked, even wide open! Some obvious measures should be adopted immediately.

- Do not admit strangers to your building, and do not allow cars or bicycles to tail-gate into your car park.
- If you have a cage, do not store your most valuable possessions in it.
- Make sure that your cage has a strong lock – and secure it!
- When thieves find an easy target, they will visit that building again: protect your neighbours' property by securing your own!



## NEW BUILDING MANAGEMENT CONTRACTS



A working group of strata representatives has spent a lot of time and expertise to find the best company to provide building management services

for Jacksons Landing. Tenders were called for and evaluated by the working group. Their recommendations have been discussed in meetings of all the participating strata chairs. A generic contract is being negotiated as a model for each strata to consider.

Since each strata must now employ its own provider, all stratas, and the Community Association, must hold Extraordinary General Meetings (EGMs) to make this decision. These meetings will be held before 30 June, when new contracts will hopefully be in place.

The Community Association EGM will be held in the Station at 6pm on Wednesday 12 June, followed by the normal EC meeting.

When "urban renewal" transformed Pyrmont, some old families remained while newcomers came from across the world. It was hard to nurture a sense of community among people who hardly knew each other.

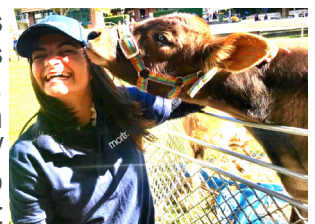
