ISTMAS IN PYRMONT - 2023 & 2024



Christmas in Pyrmont on 26 November was bigger and better than ever. By 10am Refinery Square was a dazzling array of sixty stalls. Welcome and smoking ceremony were performed by Uncle Mark Merriman and Mike Butler in time for Lord Mayor Clover Moore to open proceedings.



By every measure this event was successful. Ultimo Public School provided three musical performances (reminding us that we helped them expand their music program). Pyrmont Sings! sang, young soloists Freddie Bailey and Emily Blake and our talented local rock bands bracketed a delightful young jazz ensemble. Children were charmed by Santa and delighted to ride the fire truck.

With support from The Star, the City of Sydney, local businesses and fundraising, Christmas in Pyrmont raised over \$118,000. We distributed \$100,000 to our charities - \$25K each to Barnardos, Pyrmont Cares, Ultimo Public School and Uniting Harris Community Centre.

However, each year Christmas in Pyrmont becomes more complex to organise and manage. Next time -Sunday 24 November - will need more help, especially from younger people, to remain fresh, bringing our community together, and raising funds for local charities. The event is managed by volunteers from Ultimo School, Pyrmont Cares, Barnardos, Harris Community Centre, Domain and many locals.

It is fun to plan and manage - but each year State and City officers apply more conditions, the weather becomes less predictable – and the volunteers are another year older!
