

RULES - GLASSHOUSE POOL

Revision approved by Community Association Committee 10 April 2024

1. These rules are made pursuant to the Community Management Statement DP 270215.
2. Pool hours 5am - 11pm Monday to Sunday.
3. You must shower before entering the pool.
4. External doors must be closed on leaving the pool area.
5. Visitors must be accompanied by a resident, with no more than two visitors per residence permitted to use the pool at any one time, except for swimming lessons – see Rules 11-13.
6. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult (aged 18+ years). The presence of unsupervised children should be reported to Security.
7. Pool users are to be considerate of other users and residents at all times and must not:
 - Bring glass objects, drinking glasses, sharp objects into the pool or the surroundings.
 - Run, push, dive, dive bomb, or do anything that may be dangerous in the pool or the surroundings, including no ball games or throwing items in the pool.
 - Bring food or drink (other than water and energy drinks) into the pool or its surroundings.
 - Hold parties or other functions in the pool or surrounding areas.
 - Interfere with, operate or adjust pool equipment.
8. No large inflatable toys are permitted.
9. No smoking within the facility.
10. a. Lanes 1 to 2 are designated for children, general activities, lap walking, gentle exercise and learn to swim classes.
b. Lanes 3 to 5 are designated for lap swimming only – please share a lane at busy times by keeping to the left of the lane line.
c. No groups or classes are permitted in the lap lanes.
11. Swimming lessons – learn to swim: Learn to swim lessons may be conducted only in lanes 1-2. Classes of more than 2 people must be approved and booked with Resident Services Management and the impact of such group lessons will be reviewed by the Community Association Executive from time to time. Swim coaches are not to encroach on the enjoyment of the pool by other residents.
12. Stroke correction lessons: Only 1-2 person stroke correction lessons are permitted in the lap lanes. No larger group coaching is allowed.

13. Swim coaches: A resident may engage a coach to provide swimming lessons. The coach may or may not be a resident of Jacksons Landing. The resident who engages the coach must be in attendance during the lessons. The coach cannot initiate, organise or advertise his/her services or activities. It is the responsibility of the resident to ensure that the service provider complies with relevant legislation – e.g. teacher licence, public liability insurance, *Working With Children* Check.
14. An organised aquarobics group open to all residents may book the whole pool for two periods of one hour a week. These bookings may be made in advance for the whole of the current calendar year, and will be subject to periodic review by the Community Association Executive Committee.
15. No pets are allowed in the Glasshouse.

ALERT

Persistent or serious infringement of these rules may result in access to the pool being blocked for a period of 3 months.
