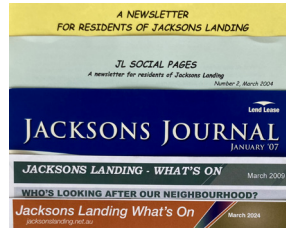


HAPPY 20TH ANNIVERSARY!

They have made use of City of Sydney grants and the invaluable assistance provided to obtain a 5 Star Energy NABERS Rating.

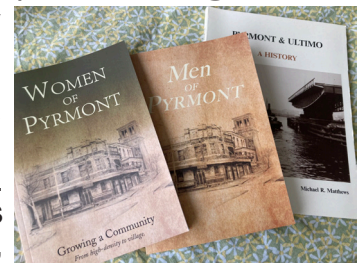
