

What should you do with your rubbish?

What can and can't be left in the loading dock

This facility is for use of residents of Regatta Wharf only
and NOT for the use of contractors

For items that do not fit in the regular garbage chute or recycling bins on each floor:

Cardboard Bin (large bin) - recycling

- Large cardboard - ensure that it fits into the bin as Council will not collect loose cardboard

E-Waste Bin (large bin) - recycling

- Mobile phones, chargers, cables, tablets
- TVs, computers, screens, keyboards, printers
- Small appliances – vacuum cleaners, microwaves
- Power tools and power boards

Battery Bin (small black bin) - recycling

- Appliance batteries
- **NO** car batteries

Light Bulb Bin (small black bin) - recycling

- Light bulbs including LED, Halogen
- **NO** fluorescent tubes

Yellow Lid Bins – general recycling

- Glass bottles, cans, plastic containers
- Paper and small cardboard boxes

Green waste (Green Lid Bins) recycling

- Plant and garden material
- **NO** food scraps, **NO** plastic bags

Red Lid Bins – to Landfill

- Household waste
- Styrofoam
- Soft plastic wrappers and bags
- Old clothes and shoes, linen, pillows

Oversized Holding Area (floor) - to Landfill

- Furniture
- Whitegoods
- **NO** clothes, shoes, linen, pillows, sporting equipment, toys or soft furnishings

- **Hazardous waste:** paint, chemicals, pesticides, partially used aerosols and household cleaners, flammable liquids, poisons, cooking oil
- **Carpets & building, renovation & demolition materials:** including kitchen cupboards, sinks, doors, plasterboard, rubble, tiles, bricks, builders waste, electrical cables, other trade waste
- **Car parts,** including motor oil, batteries and tyres
- **Plate glass** – bathroom, mirror, shower screens, table tops
- **Gas cylinders and bottles**
