

SOLAR ARRAY ON THE GLASSHOUSE ROOF

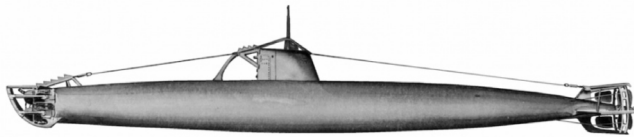

COMMEMORATING WWII

Dr Peter Hobbins is the Head of Knowledge at the Australian National Maritime Museum with a special interest in the history of Sydney Harbour in World War II. On Sunday 19 February from 5pm, he will talk about "Defending Sydney during World War II - beyond the midget submarines". The date is the anniversary of the 1942 bombing of Darwin.

ELEMENTS AND ZEBRA LOUNGE



In January the Elements restaurant on the ground floor below The Elizabeth apartments applied to Council for permission to extend west along the pathway and north towards Elizabeth MacArthur Bay.

A trial alfresco licence was put in place by Placemanagement NSW. However, protests from residents persuaded the authorities terminate the licence, and the furniture was removed.

There is still an application with Council to build a permanent awning over the eastern and northern terraces (DA #D/2022/1102).

SEABINS - AN AUSTRALIAN INVENTION

A Seabin is a floating rubbish bin that catches almost 4 kg of debris per day. Water is sucked in from the surface and passes through a bag, with clean water pumped back out.



A Seabin testing lab stands near the lighthouse next to the Maritime Museum: a building the size of a shipping container. The contents of seabins are taken to the Lab and two scientists measure the amount and sort it into different types of

litter, noting changes in the amount and type of litter over time.

I visited the Lab and found one scientist standing at a table where different types of litter were displayed, and children's questions were answered. Tours have also been arranged for 11.30 each weekday. I found a tour informative and interesting. You need not book, just turn up in time for the tour. To be sure where to go, and to check on availability of tours, check with the Maritime information desk in the Museum foyer. Leone H (editor)
