A recent forum at the Station updated attendees on PPPTF (Pymont Peninsula Public Transport Forum) progress and discussed bus issues and possible improvements with the Bus Industry Task Force representatives.

More than 100 attendees were able to comment on 389 and 501 bus services, and ideas for a new service to take in Harris St, Broadway shops, Missenden Rd, Glebe and the fish market.
