Stallholders arrived from 6am, and by 10am Refinery Square was a dazzling array of tents and gazebos protecting sixty stalls. The welcome and smoking ceremony were elegantly performed by Uncle Mark Merriman and Mike Butler



and the hygiene arrangements approved in time for Lord Mayor Clover Moore to open proceedings.



By every measure this event was a stunning success. Ultimo Public School provided three musical performances to remind us that we helped them expand their music program. Pyrmont Sings! sang, young soloists Freddie Bailey and Emily Blake and our talented rock groups performed on either side of a delightful young jazz ensemble. Many children were charmed by Santa and delighted to ride the fire truck.



With support from The Star, the City of Sydney and local businesses, and huge fundraising efforts by volunteers, Christmas in Pyrmont this year raised over \$118,000. After covering our costs, we are able to distribute \$100,000 to our charities - \$25K each to Barnardos, Pyrmont Cares, Ultimo Public School and Uniting Harris Community Centre.

CA TREASURER OPPORTUNITY

Our Community Association Treasurer is stepping down after four years. He leaves an opportunity for someone to contribute to the JL community at a high level.



This role is one of the three honorary office-bearers and contributes to the management and policy decisions of the CA. You need not be a qualified accountant (our strata manager does all the accounting) but you need to be financially literate - you'll review the CA's Balance Sheet and Income & Expense Statement and present a report to the executive committee meetings, and be involved in the annual budgeting, using projections from our building manager, strata manager and IT subcommittee.

This commitment involves an average of 4 or 5 hours per week.
