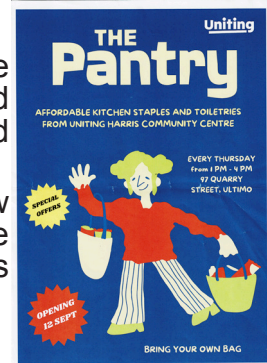


Your donations will also help us to distribute CHEX Community gift cards to those in need to shop in local businesses as well as at The Pantry.
