The upgraded ferry wharf is installed, and the F10 ferry will return to Pirrama Park very soon.



The 389 bus now stops outside the Maritime Museum and returns to Bondi Junction from outside the Star light rail stop. It is now more frequent, and investigation has commenced on a bus stop in York Street.

Light rail hours have been extended in the morning and evening.
