UNCERTAINTY & EMOTION IN THE 1900 SYDNEY PLAGUE

The 1900 plague influenced urban planning and public health policies that shaped the built environment of Sydney. Theories regarding the ecology and biology of disease transmission were transforming.



Changing understandings led to conflicts over the appropriate response. Authorities used symbols like dirt to compel emotional responses and to advocate for interventions. Disgust and aversion legitimised these actions.

Philippa Barr reflects on how emotion can change with new medical information, and our recent experience of covid19.
