Pymont Peninsula Public Transport Forum (PPPTF) transport achievements since its inception include:

F10 Ferry to Pirrama Park recommenced 7 April; Extended hours light rail; Bus stops at Maritime Museum and Pymont Bay light rail; Temporary bus stop in Sussex St; and pending Clarence St return stop; Application in process for York St bus stop; Free
